This award requires the applicant to address the following award criteria: **Criterion 1: Career and Study Achievements**

Criterion 2: Communication, team and leadership skills

- your capacity to be an effective ambassador for your industry, community and Australia.

Criterion 3: Ability to represent your industry at a broader level Tell us about:

- any knowledge or understanding you have gained of new developments and trends in your workplace or industry
- any messages you might have that could encourage others who are interested in entering the wire industry.

Criterion 4: Other pursuits

You may wish to include information about:

- your achievements in areas other than study and work
- your involvement in the community
- your awareness of current local and world issues.
